## 15A NCAC 18A . 2529 USER LOADING

In determining the maximum number of persons allowed in the pool at any one time, the following criteria shall govern:
(1) Fifteen square feet ( 1.39 sq m ) of water surface area per person shall be provided in areas of the pool five feet ( 1.52 m ) deep or less.
(2) Twenty-four square feet ( 2.23 sq m ) of water surface area per person shall be provided in areas of the pool greater than five feet $(1.52 \mathrm{~m})$ deep. Three hundred square feet $(27.87 \mathrm{sq} \mathrm{m})$ of pool area around each diving board or platform, where provided, shall not be included in computing this area for the purpose of determining maximum bather load.
(3) Ten square feet $(0.9 \mathrm{sq} \mathrm{m})$ of water surface area per person shall be provided in spas.
(4) Twenty-five square feet of splash zone area per person shall be provided at interactive play attractions.
